Central Office Updates

- Executive Director Retirement
 - Announced at the 60th GCC, Johnny Porter will retire as Executive Director effective 9/1/2022.
 - Immediate Past Grand Regent, Christy Askew, will be serving as Interim Executive Director

Central Office Updates

- Review Your Chapter's Roster Now!
 - Dues were due October 15th
 - Invoiced based on the roster on file at the Central Office
- Review and Update Your Chapter Officers
 - Confirm your officer list is correct yearly by October 15th
- New Member Fee Update
 - Increased new member fees to begin this fall
 - Costs include: Membership Card, Membership Certificate, Health and Safety Insurance Fees, Shipping fees for new member items, Fraternity operation expenses



Central Office Updates

- Chapter Spot- Expected Launch in 2023
 - Organizational Management Platform to replace current database and enhance operational efficiency
 - Product Highlights:
 - Roster and officer management by the Chapter
 - Searchable profiles and contact directory
 - Ability to update contact information by user
 - Activity Tracker: allows Chapters to track engagement such as service hours, philanthropy events
 - Enhanced billing and invoicing: ability for Chapters to see balances
 - Dashboard for centralized communications



- Grand Council Deputy Verification Form
 - Form has been updated to be completed electronically
 - Each GCD/Co-GCD/Faculty Advisor for the Chapter will be required to complete Part 1 of the form, digitally sign and submit
 - The form will be automatically forwarded to the Dean, as selected by the GCD/Co-GCD/Faculty Advisor, for their review, signature and approval
 - Completed forms will be sent to The Central Office and the approved GCD/Co-GCD/Faculty Advisor
 - The Verification Form must be completed annually by October 15, or within 30 days of election for a new GCD/co-GCD or change of a Faculty Advisor

 - Location: Cleveland, Ohio
 - Dates: Wednesday, July 24, 2024 through Saturday, July 27, 2024
 - Host Hotel: Renaissance Downtown Cleveland











- Legislative Changes from the 60th Grand Council
 - Grand Council, Provinces and Chapters are authorized to meet by electronic communication media as long as all Members have the ability to participate. This also includes committees of such named bodies.
 - Honorary and Service Orders
 - F. Harvey Smith ORDER OF THE RUBY MORTAR: 40 years of service
 - Dewey D. Garner ORDER OF THE DIAMOND MORTAR: 60 years of service
 - Norman A. Campbell ORDER OF THE PLATINUM MORTAR: 70 years of service
 - Added the ability to have an electronic ballot be conducted to amend the Constitution or Bylaws with the Grand Council adjourned



Legislative Changes from the 60th Grand Council (cont)

- Dues and Assessments
 - Initiation Fee increased to \$75.00 (effective immediately)
 - Collegiate Annual Dues (collegiate year) increased to \$60.00 (\$5/month)
 - Effective Spring 2023
 - Dues for July, August, September, October, November and December: Due October 15th
 - Dues for January, February, March, April, May and June: Due February 15th
 - Graduate Chapter Dues increased to \$200
- Nomination for Officers of the Grand Council
 - Due to The Central Office at least 6 months prior to the first day of the Grand Council Convention
 - Acceptance of nomination must be made at least 4 months prior to the first day of the Grand Council Convention



Legislative Changes from the 60th Grand Council (cont)

- Official Insignia, Badges, Et Cetera
 - Badge shall be worn on apparel, on the left chest, symbolizing being worn over the heart
- Publications
 - Removed the requirement for Collegiate Chapters to keep on file a copy of each number of The MASK
 - Chapter Historians shall submit photos and articles for publication (removes Newsletters) for The MASK
- Voting (for membership and elections)
 - Electronic voting may be permitted, provided the system is secure and can maintain the secrecy of the ballot



- The HANDBOOK
 - A completed rewrite occurred into an educational outline as a resource for Chapters to use for prospective member education
 - Available online for free to print
- Finances and Taxes
 - Taxes for chapters and provinces should be filed annually
 - Best to file early to allow adequate time for resolution of concerns and to ensure appropriate filing for awards consideration

- Kappa Psi Virtual Museum
 - Launched Summer 2022
 - Submit pictures/documents to grandhistorian@kappapsi.org
- Voluntary Graduate Dues can be paid on the website in the Kappa Psi Store
 - Exploring means to set-up recurring payment methods
- Graduate Awards, Recognition and Engagement
 - Reviewing graduate recognition and award structure
 - Growing Society 1879
 - Highlighting graduate achievements via social media
 - Opportunities for leadership development, topics and more
- Brothers moving or wishing to connect (or reconnect) with a Graduate Chapter should complete the Graduate Chapter Referral Form



Communication and Social Media Reminders

- Social Media accounts/handles for Chapters are to contain the Chapter name
 - Example: Kappa Psi Alpha Delta Chapter
- Only the Grand Regent and the Executive Director may speak on behalf of the Fraternity
- Formal position statements on any topic should not be put out by Chapters/Provinces without appropriate review and oversight
- All Chapter activities and formal communications should be reviewed by the GCD or faculty advisor
- Questions may be discussed with your GCDs and submitted to the Grand Regent at grandregent@kappapsi.org

- Information should be germane to Kappa Psi, the profession of pharmacy or health science education
- Personal fundraising/sponsorship/contest requests for non-Kappa Psi events are prohibited
- Requests for documents, information, images or other material (e.g. law study guides) protected by copyright/trademarks/patent laws may not be posted
- Items for sale by Chapters or Provinces are to be submitted to the Chapter/Province Sales Page on the Kappa Psi website
